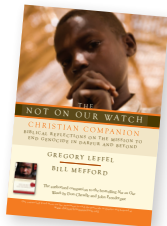

Biblical Reflections on the Mission to End Genocide in Darfur and Beyond

There is no silver bullet to eradicate genocide and crimes against humanity. But there are Christian perspectives. We can stop genocide and crimes against humanity in the future, through a framework of promoting the peace, protecting the people and accountability:

PROMOTING THE PEACE

Building peace costs less than picking up the pieces after a humanitarian crisis. We urge persistent, high-level diplomacy aimed at creating sustainable peace for a more secure future.

“He will judge between many peoples and will settle disputes for strong nations far and wide. They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore.” –Micah 4:3

PROTECTING THE PEOPLE

As we pursue peace, we must protect the innocent people. We identify and push for action that the United States and its partners must take to protect a country’s citizens from genocide and crimes against humanity when their government cannot, or will not, save them.

“You evildoers frustrate the plans of the poor, but the Lord is their refuge”

ACCOUNTABILITY

We must hold perpetrators accountable, both during and after atrocities. To break the cycle of impunity, we advocate for substantive consequences on those who commit these crimes and those who provide support, advancing a path to justice that will deter future crimes.
